
TARTAN

FOR A FUN PROJECT USE A SQUARE OF CARDBOARD AND CUT HALF INCH SLITS ALONG OPPOSITE SIDES AT ABOUT HALF AN INCH APART. WRAP YARN STARTING FROM THE BACK TO THE FRONT, DOWN THROUGH THE FIRST SLIT, AROUND BACK AND THEN THROUGH THE NEXT SLIT AND SO FORTH UNTIL YOU HAVE THE CARD FILLED WITH LENGTHWISE PIECES OF YARN. THEN, WEAVE VARIOUS COLORS OF YARN THROUGH TO CREATE YOUR VERY OWN PLAID! HAVE FUN!

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
